About the Speakers:

Mark Hargraves is currently the Director of Security for Citi in the Asia Pacific. He has spent 24 years in security management based in HK with 8 years in police service and 16 years of commercial security management across the core disciplines of Physical Security, Crisis Management, Business Continuity and Information Risk Management. He also has experience in Investigations and cyber security issues. Mark has been active in a number of security associations, including ASIS International, CSO Roundtable, TAPA and more recently in the Asia Crisis and Security Group (ACSG). Mark has been accredited as CPP and PSP and has led both CPP & PSP review courses in Hong Kong.

Karen Joe Laidler is Professor of Sociology and Director of the Centre for Criminology at the University of Hong Kong. She has been involved in criminological research – applied and theoretical – in the U.S. and Hong Kong. In the U.S., her interest in the articulation of gender and ethnicity in gangs dates back to the late 1980s. She continues to publish in this area, focusing especially on violence and drugs. In Hong Kong, her research has focused on the sex work industry, and changes in the drug market, especially the rise and problems associated with psychotropic drugs, and generational differences among heroin users.

Tyn holds a Bachelor degree in Logistics Management and started his career in 2004 when he joined Acer at the EMEA head office in Switzerland. At Acer he was responsible for claims management, loss prevention and security management. In November 2007 he moved to Shanghai to establish loss control programs with McLarens Young International, a loss adjusting and claims handling firm. In October 2010, Tyn joined TNT Express and became the Greater China Security Training and Solution Manager and was also responsible for (aviation) security, investigations, export controls and business continuity for all facilities in Hong Kong which include offices, depots, warehouses and the regional aviation hub as well as the Gateways in Mainland China. Currently Tyn works for Panalpina as Regional Head of Security for Asia Pacific. He is a co-opted Board member of the Transported Asset Protection Association (TAPA) since 2011. In Hong Kong Tyn also contributes his time to the ASIS International chapter as vice chairman.
